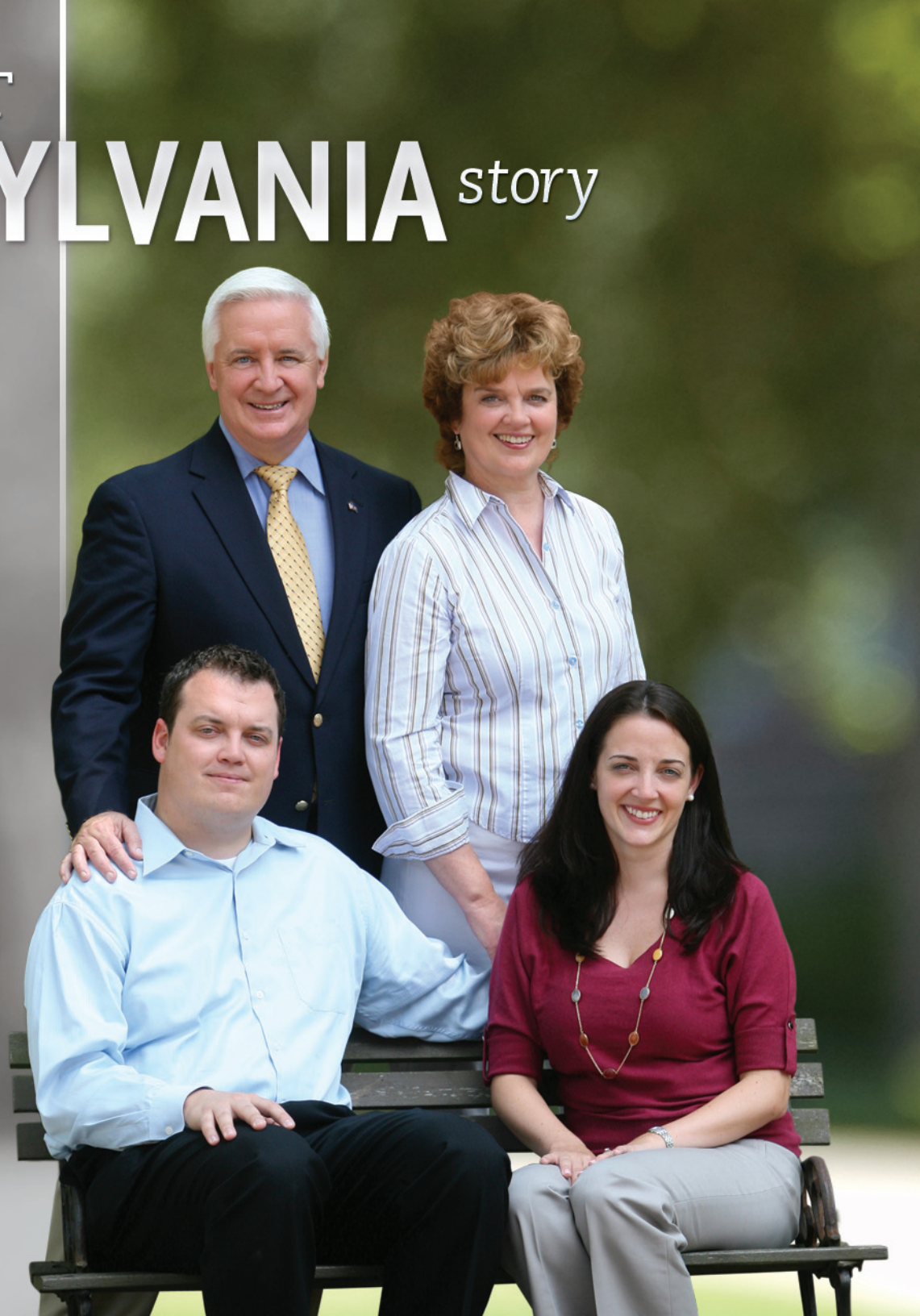
TOM CORBETT A PENNSYLVANIA *story*

Restoring Trust In Harrisburg
